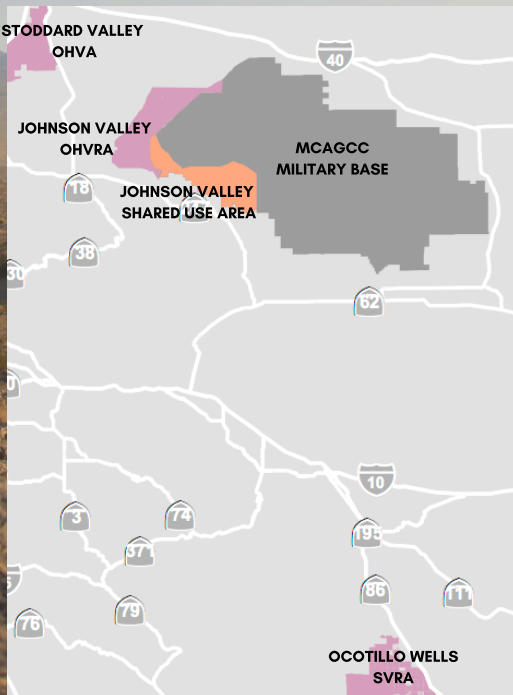
When the Shared Use Area is closed

**The Johnson Valley Shared Use Area is open to the public for most of the year. The area is closed to the public while the military trains in the area for up to two, thirty-day periods annually.**

**While the Johnson Valley Shared Use Area is closed there are other nearby areas you may recreate and off-road.**

**The Marine Corps communicates closures at least 12 months in advance to help the public in planning for recreation. ## JVOHVRA

The Johnson Valley Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Area (JVOHVRA) is managed by the Bureau of Land Management and offers more than 60,000 acres for year-round recreation. The JVOHVRA remains open even when the Johnson Valley Shared Use Area is closed for military training. ## STODDARD VALLEY

Managed by the BLM, Stoddard Valley OHV Area offers a diverse landscape for recreation. The triangular-shaped riding area is formed by Interstate 15 and California Highway 247 (Barstow Road), immediately south of Barstow. Most visitors access the area to the east, off Interstate 15 at the Outlet Center Drive Exit (Sidewinder Road) or at the Hodge Road Exit, to the south on I-15.

## OCOTILLO WELLS

Operated by the California State Parks, OHMVR Division, Ocotillo Wells State Vehicle Recreation Area offers more than 85,000 acres of magnificent desert for off-highway exploration and recreation. Located off of East State Route 78. Popular sites include Blowsand Hill, Devil's Slide, Barrel Springs and Shell Reef.
